## BENVOLIO PINOT GRIGIO ~ FRIULI

A fine aromatic, fruity white wine with a refreshing, crisp finish. Serve chilled with pasta, fish, seafood, veal and chicken dishes. – \$8.00

## MACON LUGNY “LES CHARMES” CHARDONNAY ~ BURGUNDY, FRANCE

Exceptional quality, rich and more intense than most Macons, medium-bodied, clean and fresh. Vinified in stainless steel and bottled with no oak aging. – \$8.00

## CHATEAU VALCOMBE SYRAH/GRENACHE ~ COSTIÈRES

The Tradition cuvée (Appellation Costières de Nîmes Contrôlée) is made from a fine selection of old-vines Syrah and 30% Grenache. It is fermented and aged in stainless steel to retain the fresh qualities of the fruit and is bottled unfiltered. – \$8.00

## MONTES PINOT NOIR ~ CHILE

100% Pinot Noir from the Casablanca Valley. This wine has 6 months of aging in French oak and a very soft filtering. Somewhat darker color than the typical Pinots, it has a deeper ruby color. The aroma is that of a classic Pinot Noir, with very floral notes with hints of violets and berries. – \$9.00

## PASCUAL TOSO MALBEC ~ ARGENTINA

Intense notes of blueberries and plums are reinforced by vanilla and a touch of white chocolate contributed by French oak. It is a very well-structured wine full of sweet tannins with good concentration and long persistence. – \$8.00

## IL MOLINO DI GRACE “IL VOLANO” ~ TUSCANY

This trendy producer has turned yet another stunning, top value effort. Mostly Sangiovese, this has great purity of red fruits with just a kiss of plum, but shows great balance of earthy aspects and soft acidity. 75% Sangiovese, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, Cannaiolo Nero, Merlot. – \$8.00

## RAY'S STATION CABERNET SAUVIGNON ~ ALEXANDER VALLEY

Subtle elegance and aromatic, spicy fragrances from barrel aging. This Cab, from the Stonestreet Winery Estate, is rich and complex and beautifully balanced, with soft tannins. The finish is long, rich and full. – \$9.00

*A young Giovanni Bortoluzzi known as "wine ambassador" among the top growers of Friuli, founded the Bortoluzzi Estate in 1981. Giovanni selected a few ideally placed vineyards on the gravelly, mineral enriched deposit of the diverted Isonzo River. The terroir of the 173 acres is highly prized in this privileged winemaking region. The abundant minerals in the soil make for a wine rich in fruity/floral nuances and varietals.*

***Giovanni is joined*** by his children, Alessio, assistant winemaker, Alberto, vineyard manager, and Angela, administrative, in bringing to our table a portfolio of finely crafted wines. As a personal friend of the family, our Chef Phil proudly features all of the wines of Bortoluzzi.

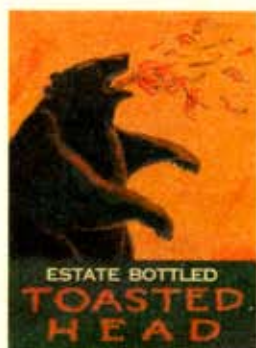

# *From the Winery of* **B. R. Cohn** “Olive Hill” Estate

*Founded by Bruce Cohn in 1984, B. R. Cohn Winery is located in the heart of Sonoma Valley.*

*This small family winery* is surrounded by the 9-acre Olive Hill Estate Vineyard where underground natural hot springs and gentle ocean breezes warm soils create a unique microclimate that makes growing conditions ideal for Cabernet Sauvignon. B. R. Cohn produces Chardonnay, Merlot and “SyrCab” from the Sonoma Valley.

The B. R. Cohn estate, in addition to wine, crafts world-class gourmet olive oils from 145 year-old Picholine trees which were imported from France in the mid-1800’s.

Since founding the winery, Cohn, with each vintage, focuses on creating wines that emphasize balance, elegance and consistent high quality.
